COURSE DESCRIPTION

Introductory survey covering all aspects of medieval society: material life, culture and religion, politics, intellectual and social change. Emphasis placed on long-term trends that contributed to the shaping of modern Europe. Course fulfills history credit for non-majors and satisfies 'before 1500' concentration requirement for history majors. Course is highly recommended for students planning to do advanced work in any subject area of the medieval studies program.
